Operations Updates: Here are updates on two important FCOB projects.

Bridge at our Elmer Derr Road property

We are delighted to report that the Operations Committee engaged Blickenstaff Logging, Inc. to construct a new steel bridge at our property on Elmer Derr Road. The bridge will be 25 feet long, 14 feet wide, and have 6-inch curbs on both sides. All funding for the bridge was donated and construction has begun. When completed and installed, the new bridge will allow farming to continue and, more importantly, will allow FCOB to reopen the property for activities and events, likely in early Spring. More will be shared as construction proceeds.

Choir Room

Reconstruction of the Choir Room, following flooding and remediation, has been delayed because of a leak in the new flat roof surface above the room. The leak has been fixed but, due to the weather, certification of the roof is being delayed. Construction will begin as soon as the certification of the flat roof is completed.

Love Puerto Rico Mission Trip: We are looking for 5 – 7 people to join these 2 week trips on April 27 – May 11 and again July 6 – 20. All lodging, meals Monday - Friday, groceries for weekend meals and transportation to/from job sites are provided by BDM. The work will be construction work rebuilding homes that were destroyed in the 2017 Hurricane Maria. There is financial help available for a portion of your airfare to Puerto Rico.
