Next Sunday— July 15 Bread & Cup Communion

Our Sermon Series, "Prayer: A Study of the Lord's Prayer" continues. Pastor Jim will preach at 8:15, 9:45 a.m. and 11:15 a.m., and Pastor Britnee at the Basement Services. **Sermon Series Description:** Using only 52 words, Jesus taught us to pray. For two thousand years the Church has recited the Lord's Prayer. Through all the change that time has brought, this prayer has remained on the lips of God's people. Why? What is it about these words that speaks to the human condition in all times and places? How do these words speak to *us today*? Join us, as we learn together from the Lord's Prayer.

Storm Damage Update: The windstorm of March 2 and the flooding of May 15-16 damaged FCOB's roof, caused much damage in the lower level of the building and damaged the access bridge at our 340 property. Work on replacing the roof will begin July 14. When the Sanctuary roof has been completed, there will be a short pause to complete the insurance settlement, with work on the remaining roof surface to occur immediately following. Estimating and project planning is being done for the lower level, with work to begin soon; the Landing will be addressed first. Which type of repairs we do on the 340 access bridge is awaiting vision and direction initiatives now being addressed by the Long-Range Planning Committee and the Leadership Team. More will be shared as projects progress. (Operations Committee)
